**Enjoy a relaxing day exploring Vienna as you wish. You might sample a strudel at a traditional "kaffeehaus," visit a museum or stroll the historic streets of beautiful Vienna. You can also join your fellow travelers on an optional excursion to Bratislava, capital of Slovakia, itself a former Imperial capital.** This evening enjoy a memorable dining experience, including local entertainment, in the picturesque wine-making village of Grinzing and sample locally produced wine. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*



**Day 7: Sunday, October 07, 2012**

**Vienna - Danube River - Melk - Vienna**  
**Travel along the banks of the Danube to the medieval town of Durnstein where you board your boat for a scenic Danube River cruise.** "Waltz" across one of the most breathtaking bodies of water in the world, immortalized by Strauss, and travel through the historic Wachau Valley. Later, visit the 11th century Melk Abbey, famous for its production and collection of manuscripts. A leisurely ride through the Vienna Woods concludes this marvelous day. Tonight, you may choose to join an optional dinner followed by an unforgettable classical music concert featuring many fine melodies from the great composers Mozart and Strauss. *Today breakfast will be included.*

**Day 8: Monday, October 08, 2012**

**Vienna - Budapest, Hungary**  
 This morning your journey continues to Budapest, the "Queen of the Danube," and truly one of the world's most beautiful cities. Divided by the mighty Danube River, the city is a combination of two former towns,

**Budapest - Domonyvolgy (Horse Show)**

Travel to the picturesque Hungarian Great Plain countryside, called the "Puszta," and visit a typical horse farm in this land which some say is "flat as water." Learn the unique culture and history of the Csikos, or Hungarian equestrians, whose equestrian lineage reaches back 1000 years. An informative city tour features the Matthias Church, site of many coronations of kings. In addition, visit the Fisherman's

Bastion with its white walls, towers and arcades for spectacular views. Continue to historic Old Buda and Gellert Hill, followed by the Parliament. At Heroes Square, admire the imposing Millennium Monument, completed in 1904, which memorializes the 1000th anniversary of Hungarian dominion. Later, visit the beautiful baroque town of Szentendre and the former Renaissance capital of Visegrad for a magnificent view of the Danube Bend and the Borzsony Mountains. Travel back in time with a visit to a 14th century castle where knights with colorful costumes and authentic weaponry recreate the days of chivalry. **Then, enjoy a special Renaissance-style dinner at the castle restaurant and reenact the days of medieval times.** Complete with wine and music, this highlight will end your fascinating cultural journey. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Built in 1755, the imperial court held many elaborate festivities here among the exotic citrus and plants protected in the glittering, baroque Orangerie. Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart debuted many pieces here, and it was here that he lost the legendary competition to court composer, Antonio Salieri, judged by the Emperor Joseph II himself. Delight to a concert of favorites by Mozart and Johann Strauss. *Duration: Approximately 5 hours.* Please note a minimum of 10 passengers is required. Transportation is included.
