#### <u>CHANGE IN THE WORKS FOR SOME</u> <u>Tricare for Life Members</u>

MOAA recently became aware that effective Oct. 1, 2006, TRICARE will no longer pay a TRICARE For Life (TFL) claim from a beneficiary who has seen a provider that has opted-out of Medicare. An opt-out Medicare provider is one who notifies Medicare that they are no longer seeking Medicare payment for their patients and cannot submit claims.
