WHO WE ARE

The New Hampshire Chapter was formed in November 1979 with the purposes, among which are, to foster fraternal relations between all branches of the various Services, to further the education of children of Service personnel, to present their rights and interests when Service matters are under consideration and to aid active and retired personnel of the various Services from which our members are drawn.

The NH Chapter has approximately 500 members. Most live in NH but we have a number who live in the surrounding states of ME, VT and MA.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

Membership in the New Hampshire Chapter is open to all who are or have been commissioned officers and warrant officers of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, Space Force, Coast Guard, National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration, Public Health Service, and of the Reserve, National Guard and other components of these Services. That includes **retired, former and current officers**. Surviving spouses are also eligible. Membership is *also* open to **retired, former and current officers** and warrant officers who are *not* members of MOAA national.
